Legacy Award

Seemal R. Desai, MD



Dr. Seemal Desai is a Diplomate of the American Board of Dermatology, and a Board-Certified Dermatologist. He graduated with honors from Emory University. He received his medical training at Morehouse School of Medicine in Atlanta, Georgia, and received his Doctor of Medicine degree with Magna Cum Laude with honors. Following medical school, Dr. Desai completed his medical internship in Internal Medicine. He then went on to complete his residency at The University of Alabama at Birmingham and served as Chief Resident for the Department of Dermatology.

Dr. Desai has been active on a local, state, and national level with numerous medical organizations, and is also actively involved in teaching and mentoring

medical students and residents. He is the Founder & Medical Director of Innovative Dermatology, a state-of-the-art private practice in the Dallas area, and also serves as Clinical Associate Professor of Dermatology at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center.

Dr. Desai is the author of hundreds of publications and has been invited to present at countless national and international Dermatology events. His clinical expertise includes the treatment of vitiligo, and other disorders of pigmentation, psoriasis, acne, skin disease in skin of color, cosmeceuticals, and new drug therapies. Dr. Desai is very active in the dermatologic community and is the Past President of the Skin of Color Society, and Past President of the Texas Dermatological Society. In addition, he is a Past President of the Dallas/Ft. Worth Dermatological Society. He also serves on the Board of Directors of the International Society of Dermatology, the Board of Directors of the Global Vitiligo Foundation, the Board of SkinPAC and previously on the Board of the Women's Dermatologic Society and the Skin of Color Society. In 2017, Dr. Desai was elected to the American Academy of Dermatology Board of Directors and also served on the AAD Executive Committee. Most prominently, Dr. Desai just completed his term as President of the American Academy of Dermatology and is the youngest dermatologist to ever be elected AAD President. He began his term as AAD President-Elect in 2023, and as AAD President in 2024. In June of 2025, Dr. Desai began his term as President of the Global Vitiligo Foundation. In 2017, and again in 2021, Dr. Desai was appointed to serve on the US Food & Drug Administration, Pharmacy Compounding Advisory Committee (PCAC), and is the only dermatologist on this federal hearing committee. He was reappointed to another full 4-year term in 2021. He also serves as the Associate Editor of the Journal of Clinical & Aesthetic Dermatology and Pigment International. He has given over 150+ lectures nationally and internationally and is passionate about advocacy and advancement of our specialty. He is married and has one daughter and one son.

Rose Hirschler Award

Diane S. Berson, MD



Diane S. Berson is an Associate Professor of Dermatology at Weill Cornell Medicine and an Attending Dermatologist at the New York-Presbyterian Hospital. She has a private dermatology practice in NYC, and volunteers in the Department of Dermatology at Weill Cornell/NY Hospital; she has been teaching medical students and residents for over 35 years. Dr. Berson received her undergraduate degree from Cornell University's College of Arts and Sciences where she was elected to Phi Beta Kappa. She pursued her medical education at New York University School of Medicine. This was followed by an internship in internal medicine at Bellevue Hospital, NYU Medical Center, and a residency in dermatology at SUNY Downstate where she served as Chief resident during her final year of training. She was certified by the American Board of Dermatology in 1988.

Dr. Berson's practice focuses on medical, surgical and cosmetic dermatology and cutaneous oncology. She has always had an interest in the treatment of acne, having conducted clinical trials, lecturing extensively and publishing articles concerning the treatment of acne and rosacea and other dermatological topics. She has been quoted in the Wall Street Journal and The New York Times, and many magazines including Allure, In Style, Town and Country, Health, Real Simple, Fitness, Self, Good Housekeeping, Glamour, W and more. She has also been interviewed often in the media, including NBC's Today Show, The CBS Early Show, ABC World News Tonight, CNN Headline News, MSNBC, Fox News and the local news networks. She lectures regularly at national dermatology conferences. Dr. Berson is on the editorial boards of Practical Dermatology, Journal of Drugs in Dermatology and Dermatologic Surgery.

Dr. Berson served on the Board of Directors of both the American Academy of Dermatology and the American Society of Dermatologic Surgery. She is a Past President of the Women's Dermatologic Society and served on its Board of Directors and the Executive, Legacy, Awards, Networking, and Fundraising committees. She also received the WDS Legacy Award. She has been a member of the Medical Council of the Skin Cancer Foundation, the Board of Trustees of the Dermatology Foundation, and is a Founding Board Member of both the American Acne and Rosacea Society and the American Society of Cosmetic Dermatology and Aesthetic Surgery. Dr. Berson is a media spokesperson for The American Academy of Dermatology and was elected to the American Dermatological Association. She is also a member of the President's Council of Cornell Women and the Cornell University Council.

Personal Statement: I am extremely honored and touched to receive this special award. Rose Hirschler exemplified courage and leadership; she was the first woman dermatologist in the US and only woman among the founders of the AAD. She actually had a strong interest in acne management, which has always been a passion of mine.

We have come so far as women in this specialty, and I know we are all grateful for the significant role the WDS has played. Our society has always supported mentorship, leadership, networking, education, community service and collegiality. I have been so fortunate to serve the WDS in many roles, and treasure the personal friendships and professional relationships that were fostered as a result. I thank Rose Hirschler for planting the seed and my WDS family for this incredible honor!

The Rose Hirschler Award is named in honor of Dr. Rose Hirschler, one of the first known female dermatologists in the United States. The award is presented annually by the WDS to physicians chosen for their significant contributions to medicine and dermatology and who, by their achievement, have served to enhance the role of women in the dermatologic specialty.

Wilma Bergfeld, MD Visionary & Leadership Award

Tina Alster, MD



Tina S. Alster, MD is the founding director of the Washington Institute of Dermatologic Laser Surgery and is a clinical professor of dermatology at Georgetown University Medical Center in Washington, DC. She received her B.S. and M.D. degrees with highest honors from Duke University and completed her dermatology residency at Yale University.

Dr. Alster is a world-recognized leader in dermatologic laser surgery and is credited with having written the first textbook on cosmetic laser surgery. During her career, she has published hundreds of articles and 7 additional textbooks on the subject. Her commitment to teaching and mentoring others is evident in the hundreds of physicians she has trained in her career as well as her establishment of

scholarship endowments for women pursuing careers in medicine at Duke University and a cosmetic dermatology resident education fund at Yale University.

Dr. Alster has held and maintains leadership and board positions in numerous professional and national organizations including the Women's Dermatologic Society (WDS), American Society for Dermatologic Surgery (ASDS), American Society for Laser Medicine & Surgery (ASLMS), among others. She served on the Board of Visitors at Duke University School of Medicine, on the Board of Directors for Ford's Theatre, and as a consultant to several skin care and device companies, including Lancôme and La Mer.

Dr. Alster has received numerous professional accolades including the Women's Dermatologic Society Mentorship (2009) and Legacy (2014) Awards, ASDS Samuel Stegman Award for Distinguished Service (2019) and Vic Narurkar MD Innovations in Aesthetic Dermatology Award (2022), ASLMS Leon Goldman Lectureship Award (2001), Leadership, Mentorship & Public Advocacy for Women in Medical Science Award (2018), and Ellet H. Drake Award (2026), AAD Presidential Citation Award (2017), Dermatology Foundation Practitioner of the Year Award (2019), and Masters of Aesthetics Fitzpatrick Award (2022). She has been a Castle Connolly Top Doctor in America for over 3 decades and has been consistently ranked among the nation's top 1 percent of physicians in dermatology in US News & World Report.

Personal Statement: Receiving the Wilma Bergfeld MD Visionary Leadership Award is both humbling and deeply personal. It represents the power of women supporting women, of mentorship that lifts others as we rise, and of vision grounded in purpose rather than prestige.

Dermatology has given me a platform to innovate, to teach and to advocate- for patients, for science, and for the next generation of leaders. This honor affirms that thoughtful leadership, curiosity and perseverance can create meaningful change. I accept it with gratitude, mindful of those who guided me and committed to paying that trust forward.

Lawrence Green, MD



Lawrence J Green, MD FAAD is a Clinical Professor of Dermatology at George Washington University School of Medicine in Washington DC, where he participates as an attending physician in resident surgery clinic on a regular basis. He has a private practice in Rockville, Maryland, where he oversees, as principal investigator a clinical research practice that performs Phase II-IV trials. Dr Green received his medical degree from New York Medical College and completed his residency in dermatology and dermatologic surgery as well as a clinical research fellowship at the University of California, Irvine. He is a diplomat of the American Board of Dermatology.

Dr Green is the incoming Vice-President of the AAD, and a current Board Member of the WDS. He is also a current board member of the National Psoriasis Foundation, a past member of the AAD and ASDS board of directors, and the National Psoriasis Foundation Medical Advisory Board. On a local level, he is a current member of the Maryland Medical Society board of directors and co-chair of its Legislative Council. Dr Green received the National Psoriasis Foundation clinician of the year award in 2019, the AAD's advocate of the year award in 2018, the ASDS President's Award in 2009 and the ASDS Patient Safety Hero Award in 2015. He has also received multiple Presidential Citations from the AAD. Dr Green serves as an editor for the Journal of the American Academy of Dermatology, the Journal of Aesthetic and Clinical Dermatology, Cutis, and The Dermatologist periodicals. He is an author on over 100 publications.

Dr Green and his wife Allison have 2 adult children (and one favorite son in law).

Personal Statement: It is an honor to be selected for the Shelley award! The list of previous recipients, starting with Dr Walter Shelley, all represent true leaders and teachers in dermatology. I am humbled to be included with them.

The Walter B. Shelley, MD Leadership Award

Terry Cronin, MD



Dr. Terry Cronin is a Florida dermatologist whose career exemplifies exceptional clinical expertise, transformative leadership, and dedicated service to dermatologists and our patients.

Dr. Cronin earned his medical degree from Wake Forest University and completed his dermatology residency and served as chief resident at the University of Miami, where he remains a voluntary professor, mentoring future dermatologists.

For nearly two decades, Dr. Cronin has been a pivotal leader in organized dermatology. He served as President of the American Academy of Dermatology (2023–2024),

Advisory Board Chair, and member of the AAD Board of Directors, and currently sits on the Organizational Structure Committee. He has also held presidency roles at the American Society for Mohs Surgery, Florida Academy of Dermatology, and Florida Society of Dermatology and Dermatologic Surgery, and served on the board of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery.

A champion of education and innovation, Dr. Cronin was Editor-in-Chief of *Dialogues in Dermatology*, where he collaborated with Dr. Shadi Kourosh to transition the program from CDs to a modern digital app platform that continues to educate dermatologists worldwide. He recently co-edited a “best-selling” surgical textbook with his dermatologist father, Dr. Terry Cronin Sr., and niece, Dr. Megan Cronin.

Honored as “Practitioner of the Year” and “Sunscreen Advocate” by the Florida Society of Dermatology and Dermatologic Surgery, Dr. Cronin maintains a thriving private practice in Melbourne, Florida, delivering compassionate, high-quality care. He co-hosted an innovative Women’s Dermatologic Society seminar with Dr. Shawna Flanagan on “Improving Bedside Manner with Humor,” featuring comedian Lisa Corrao, underscoring his commitment to enhancing patient experiences.

A devoted husband and father of five, Dr. Cronin’s leadership and service have profoundly advanced dermatology education, patient advocacy, and professional standards. He currently serves as the Vice Mayor of Melbourne Beach, Florida.

Personal Statement: I’m truly honored to receive the Walter B. Shelley Leadership award. This recognition from an organization that has done so much to elevate women in Dermatology means a great deal to me. Women dermatologists have long been among the strongest leaders in our field as trailblazing clinicians, accomplished researchers, and fearless advocates who consistently raise the bar for all of us. Jane M. Grant-Kels, MD



Jane was founding Chair of the Division and then Department of Dermatology at the University of Connecticut, from 1979-2015 when she voluntarily stepped down to allow the next generation to be leaders. She was founding Director of UCONN's Dermatology Residency, Dermatopathology Laboratory, and Cutaneous Oncology Center / Melanoma Programs. Presently she is Professor of Dermatology, Pathology and Pediatrics, Department Vice Chair, and associate residency director at UCONN as well as Adjunct Professor of Dermatology at the University of Florida. After attending Smith College for 3 years, she attended Dartmouth Medical College and then Weill Cornell University Medical College. She trained in pediatrics and dermatology at Cornell's New York

Hospital and completed a dermatopathology fellowship at NYU with Bernie Ackerman. Founding Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Clinical Medicine and founding Co-Editor-in-Chief of the International Journal of Women's Dermatology, Jane is now Deputy Editor of JAAD. She has been an elected board member of: WDS (2011-2016), APD (1999-2002) and AAD (2014-2018). She was elected to the ADA in 2003 and was elected AAD's VP (2019-2020).

Jane was the recipient of WDS's 2018 Rose Hirschler Award, AAD 2014 Professionalism Award, AAD 2016, 2017, 2021 Presidential Citations. and AAD 2022 Honorary Membership Award. The American Society of Dermatopathology honored her with the 2022 Elson B. Helwig Memorial Lectureship and the AAD with the 2023 Clarence S. Livingood, MD Memorial Award. She has received several teaching awards and enjoys teaching/mentoring as well as caring for patients with high-risk pigmented lesions, reflectance confocal microscopy, dermoscopy and dermatoethics. She has published >780 peer reviewed manuscripts, 169 chapters, guest edited 31 journals, edited or co-authored 8 books, and delivered >1,000 invited lectures. She and her husband Barry (married 51+ years) have 4 children (2 are in-law), 5 awesome grandchildren and 1 dog and 2 grandogs.

Personal Statement: Thank you for this incredible recognition. Growing up in the 1950's-60's, I never benefitted from a female mentor due to the paucity of professional women. And sadly some seemed to pull the ladder up behind themselves rather than offering a hand-up.
