## **Jennifer Adams MD, FAAD, DTM&H**

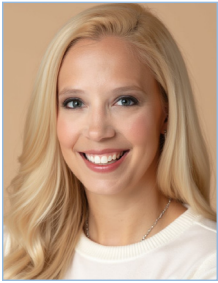


**Marissa Lobl, MD, PhD**

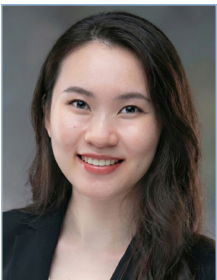


**Ashley Wysong, MD, MS, FACMS**

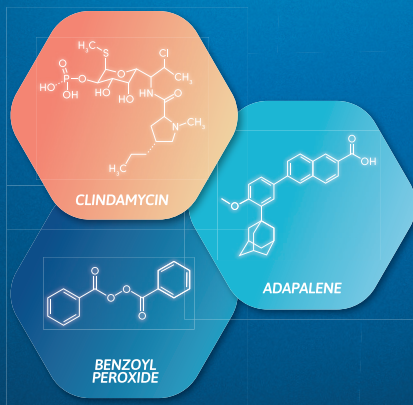
